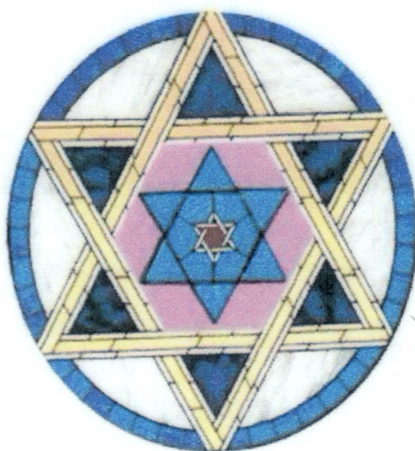
The people of Israel shall keep Shabbat,
